Abstract

The PM of India recently declared 2012 the “National Mathematical Year” to commemorate the 125th Anniversary of the birth of the Indian Mathematician S. Ramanujan. In this mainly expository talk, we will recall the story of how Ramanujan had to overcome great difficulties before his talent was recognized. We will also discuss some of his mathematical results discovered almost a hundred years ago and their relevance to modern mathematics.
