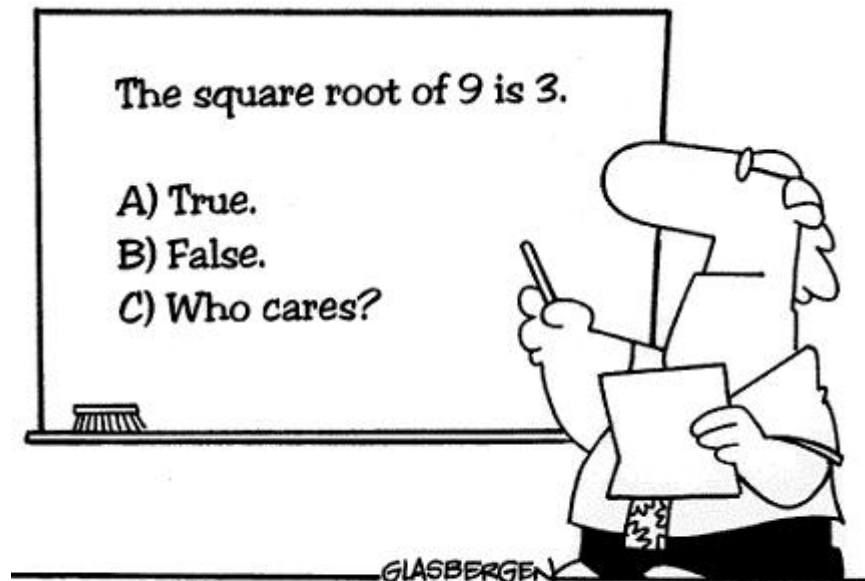
Professor : Aren't you afraid that I can integrate you?!!
